The proportion, in which questions are going to be asked from the different sections of the syllabus in the General Studies paper, is not fixed. Generally, more questions were asked from History, Polity, Environment and Ecology, Economics and Geography. The tendency of change in pattern is apparent from 2023 paper onwards. Thus, the proportional distribution of questions is something which is very uncertain.
